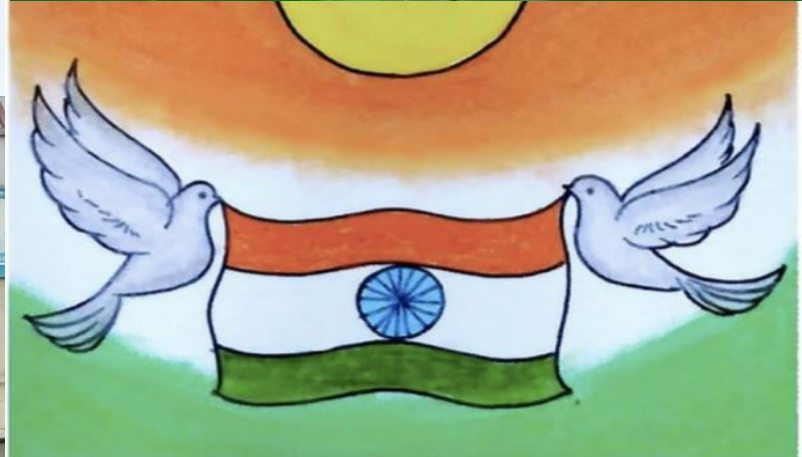
REPUBLIC DAY CELEBRATION
